

Sister Eva Batta

At the end of her 75th Jubilee Mass, Sister Eva shared with those gathered, "I am so deeply grateful to our Lord that He touched my heart at such an early age. I was 15 years old when I made a lifetime decision to answer the call of the Lord Jesus and, thanks be to God, I never waivered.... In the Community we went through difficult times, but never alone. Our Lord ran with us. When the persecution began in Communist Hungary, He protected and helped us... as we travelled on the stormy ocean in a loaded refugee boat.... During this time I learned that when our Lord calls us to follow Him, He is right there. His Holy Spirit inspired and gave me great joy as I was teaching His children, youth, catechists and catechumens, leading Girls' Camps...whatever assignment I was given. Little did I know at 15, in a small country in Europe, that I would be here today looking back at 75 blessed years. I never stop rejoicing that the Lord Jesus called and sent me to continue His work on earth."

Sister Arlene Te

As an obstetrician-gynecologist, Arlene came to know the Sacred Heart Sisters through her medical work at Cardinal Tien Hospital in Taipei, Taiwan where Sister Mary Ann was the Medical Director. Sister Arlene shared that her response to her vocation to our community came when she visited the Sisters in Los Angeles in 1990 on the occasion of (Sister Ida's and the community's) 50th anniversary. "I was attracted to the joyful spirit of the Sisters and the team work."

Sister Arlene entered the Society in 1990. She is currently the Director of Family Medicine at Cardinal Tien Hospital.
